Proposed Governance Structure

The Regional Organizations have been created by VGFOA to be an integral part of VGFOA's overall member outreach program. These organizations fall under the overall corporate structure of VGFOA specifically as it relates to its organization under Virginia State Law and International Revenue Service 501 c(3). These organizations are not considered a separate body nor does VGFOA endorse the creation of separate regional organizations.

Each organization will be headed by a Coordinator, who will be part of the Regional Organization Committee and whose appointment will be approved by the VGFOA Board.

All Regional Organization activities will be governed by VGFOA by-laws and policies.
