Special Purpose Faculty in Finance Position

The Department of Accounting, Finance & Business Law (AFBL) in the Davis College of Business and Economics at Radford University invites applications for a full-time Special Purpose faculty appointment in Finance beginning August 10, 2023. The position involves teaching four classes each semester in the area of Finance and providing service to Department, College, and University.

A successful applicant must have, at a minimum, a graduate degree in Finance or an affiliated discipline, with at least 18 graduate hours completed in Finance, with demonstrated professional experience. Applicants must be considered a qualified instructor per AACSB accreditation requirements as well as by the standards of the Davis College of Business and Economics. Evidence of successful instructional experience at college level and graduate degree from an AACSB accredited business school is preferred. Continued employment is contingent upon maintaining necessary faculty qualifications per the standards of the Davis College of Business and Economics.

Nestled in the New River Valley in the Blue Ridge Mountains, 40 miles from Roanoke, Radford University is a co-educational, doctoral/professional midsize public university. RU is a student-focused institution offering more than 150 outstanding undergraduate and graduate programs.
